Objectives	To explain to the students the most popular recent trends in management. To teach about what are the career prospects in the recent trends of management. To explain to students the latest managerial practices that managers use to effectively manage their employees.
Content	Dr Anju Bala, a faculty member at MIMT, opened the seminar with a welcome address for the resource person, Dr Madhu Arora. Dr Arora explained the current unstable economic environment at the outset of the session and went on to add that change has accelerated dramatically in recent years and has now become a daily reality for businesses and organisations. Organizations must adapt to changing environmental conditions to be competitive and profitable in today's complex and competitive global business world. She expertly explained how the conditions conditioned by the new modern society, which conditioned the birth of new management methods and technologies, often do not meet the approaches that have worked in the past. She outlined the top five managerial trends of late, including headlessdigital transformation, technology, automation, personalization, and tool integration. She stressed how these technologies are altering the corporate landscape and will have a greater impact in the future. In her lecture, she also touched on augmented reality, blockchain, and AI. The resource person also covered the kinds of employment that management students can apply for in various descriptions.

An increase in digitalization is leading firms and educational institutions to shift to workfrom-home (WFH). Blockchain technology will become important and will entail research on design and regulations. Gig workers and the gig economy are likely to increase in scale, raising questions about work allocation, collaboration, motivation, and aspects of work overload and presenteeism. The session was concluded by rendering a thank you note.	
Outcome of Activity	Students understand that a pandemic can have severe consequences including changing the political contour of the world, destroying empires and creating nations. For the Covid-19 pandemic, we envisage a dramatic shift in digital usage with impacts on all aspects of work and life. 

training and development, developing roles, assessments and motivation, health and safety, and pay.

Dr Shweta Kulshrestha talked about the potential career paths in finance. She clarified that the field of finance is broad and involves both the process of raising money and how it is managed. She underlined that having a solid understanding of the most effective strategies for raising and investing cash is just as important for a career in finance as having a solid grasp of accounting fundamentals. Additionally, she discussed a few specific job descriptions that are in high demand right now on the job market, including financial analyst, financial consultant, portfolio manager, investment banker, financial advisor, risk manager, credit analyst, and many others. She also mentioned that students who want to specialise in finance get knowledge in subjects including business restructuring, tax planning, derivatives, budgeting, and banking.

Mr. Rupesh Rao talked about potential careers in the field of operations. She helped the students comprehend that operations management includes planning, coordinating, directing, and managing the full production schedule of a product or service from the input stage to the finished output. She skillfully demonstrated how the operations management team would track the order placed, the payment method used, and inventories to final shipment, delivery, and customer feedback by using examples of e-commerce setups like Amazon or Flipkart. In addition, she went to great lengths regarding the different career paths one may take in the field of operations management, including supply chain and logistics management, inventory control managers, process managers, delivery and returns managers, etc. Students who choose to specialize in operations management will read papers on supply chains and logistics.

Mr. Bharat Gahlot discussed potential career paths in the area of global business. She told the students that education in international business will equip them for a global, varied career with prospects in a variety of sectors and industries. She added that it's advised for students to demonstrate a clear interest in diverse cultures and that speaking a foreign language would be a big plus for them if they planned to specialize in international business or hoped to work for a multinational corporation. She also spoke about several of the key international business courses, including Transnational Corporations

in the World Economy, Global Entrepreneurship, and Principles of International Business.

She gave the students an overview of marketing by explaining that it is an organizational function and a collection of implementing, organizing, developing, procedures for communicating, and providing customers with value as well as for managing customer relationships in a way that is advantageous to the organization and its stakeholders. Dr Shruti Srivastava discussed the career prospects in the field of HR. She stated that HR is a professional career that demands integrity, confidentiality and a high level of interpersonal interaction abilities from its practitioners. She explained to the students that your ability to contribute to employee development, organization development, employee retention, and a positive, motivating work environment is critical to business success and consequently, these are expectations of the contributions of HR staff. creating better workplaces for a better world. She discussed that students who will opt for HR specialization will have career opportunities in the areas like recruitment, selection, training and development, designing jobs, assessments and motivation, health and safety, and compensation.

Dr Pooja Kapoor discussed the career prospects in the field of finance. She explained that Finance covers a lot of ground and includes not only how money is managed but also the process of how funds are acquired. She emphasized that a career in finance requires not only an understanding of accounting principles but also a clear understanding of the best tactics for raising and investing capital. She also talked about a few particular job profiles which are presently in demand in the job market like Financial Analyst, Financial Consultant, Portfolio Manager, Investment Banker, Financial Advisor, Risk Manager, Credit Analyst and many others. She also discussed that the students who opt for finance specialization get insight into the areas like budgeting, derivatives, tax planning, banking, corporate restructuring, investment analysis and portfolio management, financial markets and services.

Mr Bharat Gahlot discussed career prospects in the field of operations.He made students understand that Operations Management oversees the entire production timeline of a product or service from the input stage to the finished product, including planning, organizing, directing and supervising. Citing examples of e-commerce setups such as Amazon or Flipkart, he fluently explained that the operations management team would track the order placed, the payment method selected, and inventory to final shipping, delivery and customer feedback. He also discussed in detail the career options in the field of operations management like Supply Chain & Logistics Management, Inventory Control Manager, Process Managers, Delivery and Returns Managers etc.Students who will opt for Operations Management specialization will study papers like: supply chain and logistics management, quality toolkit for managers, project management, pricing and revenue management, operations strategy, sales and operations planning, behavioural operations management, operations research applications, management of manufacturing systems, sourcing management, supply chain analytics.

Mr Sushil Kumar Maurya talked about career prospects in the field of international business. With his rich experience, he explained to students that a degree in international business prepares them for a

He further emphasized that if students are looking to specialize in international business or hope to join a global company, they should show a clear interest in different cultures and an ability to speak a foreign language would be a great advantage for them. He also discussed some of the important modules of international business such as Principles of International Business, Global Entrepreneurship, Cross-Cultural Management and Transnational Corporations in the World Economy. Students were told about the areas they will be covering such as international marketing management, international trade laws, international labour organization and international labour laws, export & import management, international finance and international HRM.

Ms. Ruchi Rayat had discussed career prospects in the field of marketing.
