1. To approve the previous committee's minutes

2. Annual Report of Anti-ragging Committee -2016-17
 - No ragging incident, in any form was reported on the campus.
 - Orientation about the anti-ragging committee was conducted and anti-ragging squad were inducted on the campus.
 - Flex were displayed on all Notice Boards of department, hostels and at vulnerable places.
 - Anti-ragging awareness drives were conducted regularly, particularly during the first month of the beginning of the academic session.
3. ARC Action Plan for 2017–18
 - After a thorough discussion, the following points were resolved-
 - Ragging in all forms is strictly prohibited in the premises of the institute. Strict actions will be taken against any person found guilty and/or of abetting this misconduct.
 - The provision under ARC should continue to be displayed at all the prominent places in the institute for their wide dissemination


