2. Review of ARC -2019-20 annual report-

 - The committee organized an anti-ragging orientation program.
 - Anti-ragging campaigns were carried out frequently, mostly in the first month of the academic session.
 - A poster-making competition was organized on the 'ill effects of ragging' in the institute.

 - For wide dissemination of the ARC's provisions and policies, it has been already posted at all the noticeable locations in the institute with the list of names of the members of the committee. .
 - Students are regularly informed about the negative impact of ragging using whatsapp media.
