PURPOSE:

SCOPE:

they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each Party's contributions, deliverables. This MOU places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either party. MODE OF OPERATION

Within the broad frame work of the MOU, NGO and MIMT Institute can work on outreach and awareness activities, development of facilities etc.

Any financial commitment for joint activities under this MOU shall be subject to the approval by the Competent Authorities of the respective organizations.

LOGOS, NAMES AND MARKS:

The parties agree that neither this document nor any performances or actions taken in connection therewith shall create a partnership or joint venture between them, nor that neither advertises state nor otherwise imply anything to the contrary. Unless otherwise

agreed in writing, neither party shall use, display or otherwise engage the logos, names, trademarks, or other identification or protected intellectual property of the other without prior permission.

NOTICE:

Any notice, approval, consent, request or other communication required or permitted to be given or made under the alliance will be in writing in English language and will be served or delivered to the registered office address of the individual party as placed in this alliance in its preamble.

Now both the parties have reached to the following understanding/agreement, in principle agreement of collaboration

NOW, FURTHER, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements set forth herein, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

- a. The duration of this MOU shall be applicable until the duration of five years or until both the parties are ready to withdraw/extend the program.
- b. Both Party will allow clicking the photographs, making videos, taking testimonials during the activities and awareness program and publishing all material on both the Party website, mobile application, and proposal being used by the both the party.
- c. In case of non-resolution by mutual negotiation, all disputes arising out of this MOU shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by both the Parties.
- d. The MOU shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Courts in Greater Noida. [UP]
- e. No provisions of this MOU may be amended, modified or waived unless by an instrument in writing executed on behalf of each of the Parties by their respective duly authorized officers.
- f. The parties would highlight this MOU and seek gains of media coverage. However, this is clarified that this MOU is not exclusive to either party.
